

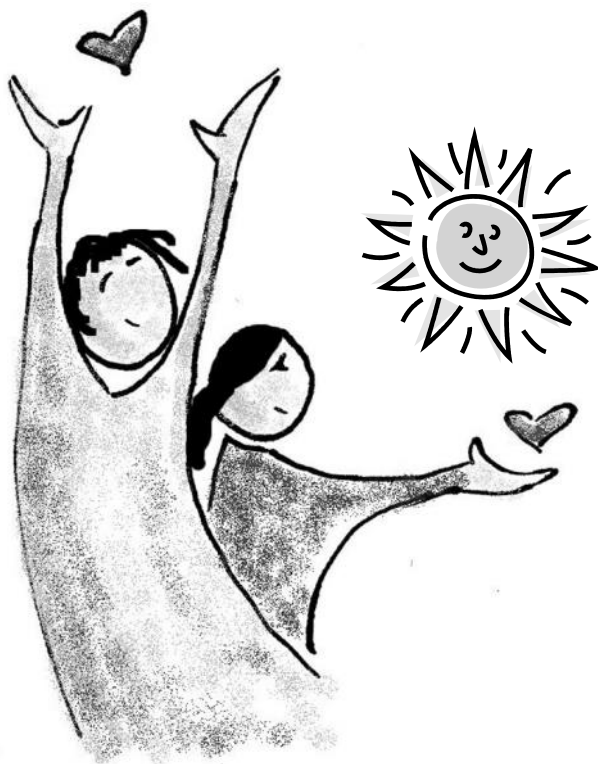

Team lists can be found on the pages following. Please know that your participation and help is necessary and greatly appreciated when you are called and asked to fulfill a need.

Each team is headed by a chairwoman who will serve a one year term from April 1st to March 31st, after which her name will be moved to the bottom of the list, moving up the next name on the list to fill the position. If you are unable to help in this capacity for any reason, please let one of the organization officers know. You may be able to help us in another way.

Teams will take turns contributing their services for church social events that come up during the year. The main events are:

- First Communion
- Senior Mass

Serve in other ways within the organization:

- Honor Guards who are present at funerals of deceased members. The Honor Guard arrives 45 minutes before the funeral service to say the Rosary. During the service they sit together as a body and form a guard outside the church after the service has ended.

St. Patrick's Irish Stew

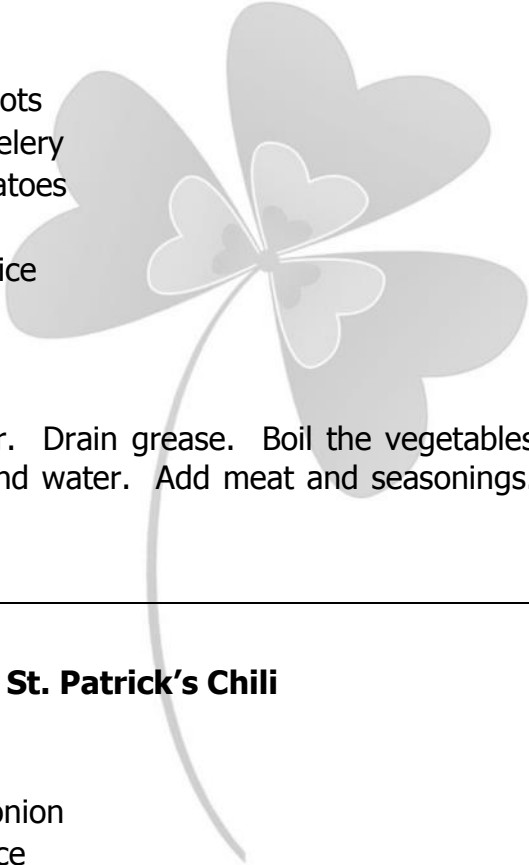
2 lbs. hamburger
1 chopped onion
2 cups diced carrots
2 cups chopped celery
2 cups diced potatoes
5 1/2 cup water
4 cups tomato juice
3 tsp. salt
1 1/2 Tbsp. sugar

Brown hamburger. Drain grease. Boil the vegetables in tomato juice and water. Add meat and seasonings. Simmer 1 hour.

St. Patrick's Chili

2 lbs. hamburger
1 large chopped onion
2 cans tomato juice
1/2 cup catsup
2 tsp. Worcestershire
1/4 cup brown sugar
2 Tbsp. chili powder
2 cans red beans (drained)

Brown and drain hamburger and onion. Add tomato juice, catsup, Worcestershire, brown sugar, chili powder, and beans. Simmer for 1-2 hours.
