**SPIRITUAL ADOPTION:** We encourage all members of our OLMC parish to spiritually adopt a pre-born baby that may be in danger of abortion. During the nine months from the Feast of the Annunciation (March 25th to Jesus' conception in the womb of Mary) until Jesus' birth on Christmas, each person or each family is to say the following prayer daily: *Jesus, Mary and Joseph, I love you very much. I beg you to spare the life of the pre-born baby that I have spiritually adopted who is in danger of abortion. Amen.*

There are posters at the back of church following the monthly development of the babies we have adopted. Parents are encouraged to use this spiritual adoption process as a way to teach their children about God's precious gift of life.
